







CHEMTREC HELP Award Program

- Annual award established in 2019
- Awards are intended to help fire departments
 - Enhance their response capabilities
 - Increase local preparedness to respond to and prepare for hazardous materials incidents
- CHEMTREC will continue the partnership with the National Volunteer Fire Council (NVFC) to provide \$10,000 each to three volunteer fire departments in the US in 2022.

\$85,000 has been provided to volunteer fire departments!








TRANSCAER Augmented Reality Scenario DOT 117 Handle






TRANSCAER Mobile Application
